

By the Numbers 2016

The Need

1 in 4 residents is in need of food assistance in San Francisco and Marin.

225,000 people are nourished by food from the Food Bank every year.

Transforming Lives

30,000 families receive fresh groceries at our pantries every week.

44,000 children receive food through our programs every year.

28,000 seniors receive home-delivered groceries, supplemental food boxes, or pick up food at our pantries every month.

Last year we helped **2,144 households** apply for CalFresh. Families enrolled by the Food Bank were awarded over **\$5 million in benefits** to buy groceries.

Each year, more than **2,000 people** attend our nutrition education classes.

Nutritious Food

About 49 million pounds of food will be delivered throughout San Francisco and Marin this year...

...that's enough for over 100,000 meals each day.

60% of our food distribution is made up of **fresh fruits and vegetables**.

Dedicated Partners

419 non-profit partners rely on us to supply food for their food programs.

Together with these community partners we run **253 weekly farmers' market-style pantries** throughout San Francisco and Marin. They are located in places like schools, supportive-housing sites, churches, and community centers.

About **40,000 volunteers** sort and repack food at our warehouses every year.

Accountability

For each \$1 donated, we are able to provide \$5 worth of food.

96% of donated resources are applied directly to our programs.
