

“Missing Meals” in SF and Marin

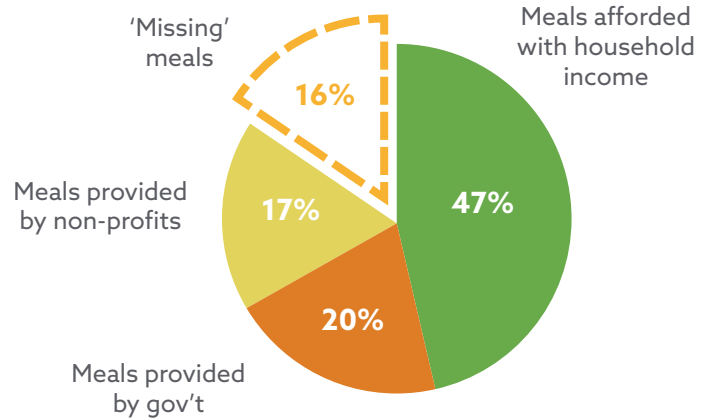
In San Francisco and Marin, 23.5% of the population is at risk of food insecurity. That's 260,000 people living below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Collectively, they need 287 million meals throughout the year - 3 meals a day, for 365 days.

Some of those meals they buy themselves, and others are provided by non-profit organizations and government assistance programs.

**But even with this help,
1 out of 6
meals is still unaccounted for.**

Where do needed meals come from in San Francisco and Marin?

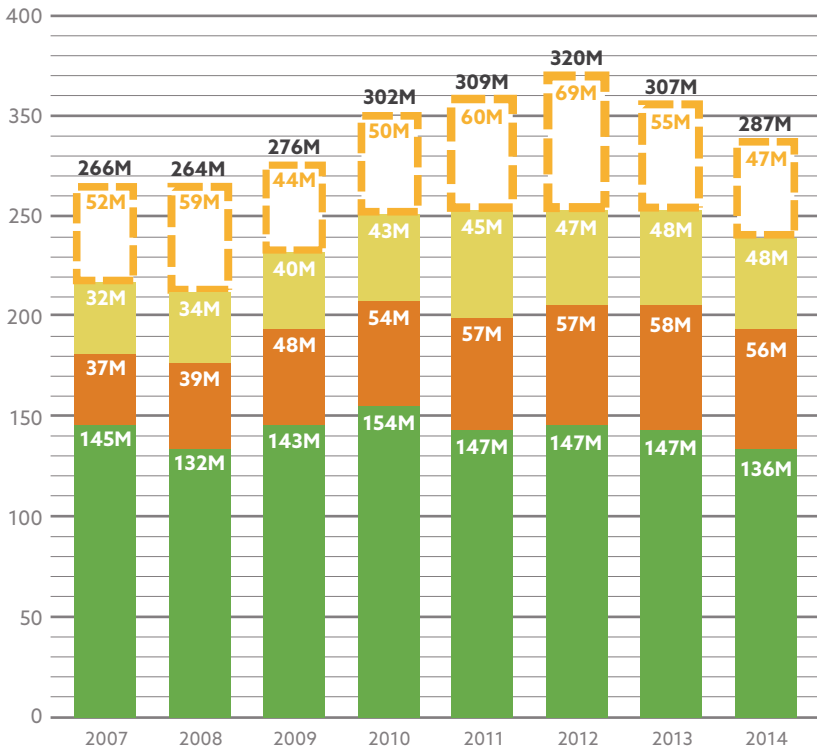

Meals unaccounted for

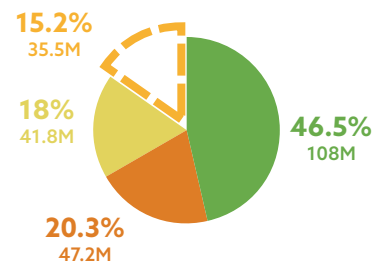
Meals provided by non-profits

Meals afforded with household income

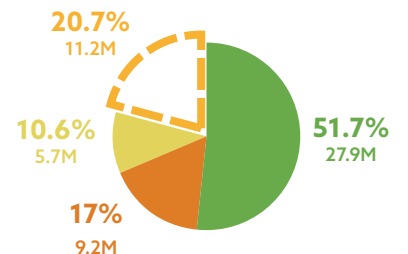
