

“Missing Meals” in SF and Marin


In San Francisco and Marin,
21% of the population is at risk of food insecurity.
That’s **240,000 people** living below 200%
of the Federal Poverty Level.

Collectively, they need **263 million meals**
throughout the year — 3 meals a day, for 365 days.

Some of those meals they buy themselves,
and others are provided by non-profit organizations
and government assistance programs.

BUT EVEN WITH THIS HELP,
1 out of 7
MEALS IS STILL UNACCOUNTED FOR.

Where do low-income neighbors get their food?



35 million meals are “missing” in San Francisco and Marin Counties.


Missing Meals in San Francisco and Marin

(Millions of Meals)


