

26 MILLION MEALS

are missing in San Francisco and Marin Counties.



In San Francisco and Marin, **1 in 5** residents is at risk of food insecurity. That's **224,000 people** living below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Collectively, they need **245 million meals** throughout the year. Some of those meals they buy themselves, and others are provided by non-profit organizations and government assistance programs.

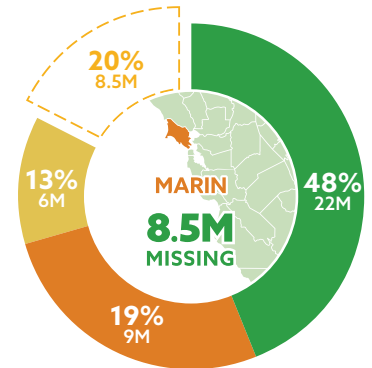
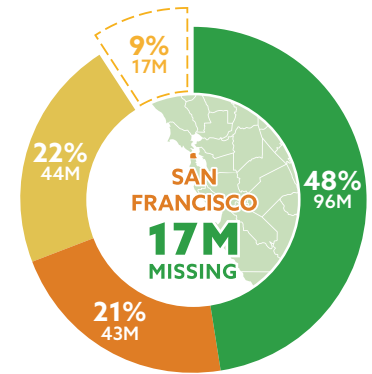
